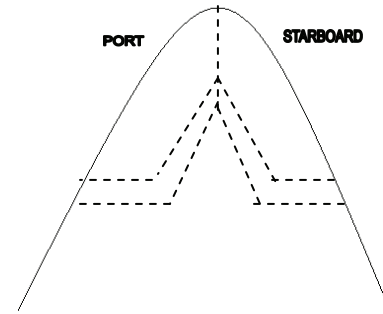

With a little time, a tape measure and large sheets of paper, it is possible to come up with workable measurements for custom cushions, covers or bunks.

Getting A Pattern for Bunks:

1. Tape paper together and fit into bunk area
2. Cut extra paper out of the way
3. Identify which bunk pattern you have made.



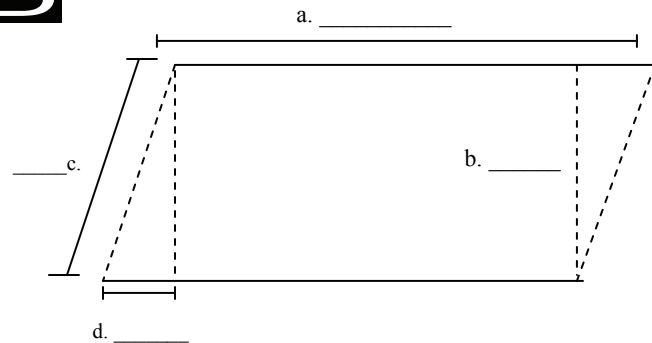
- Indicate upper and lower bunks. (See diagram A)
4. Add any special instructions / notes right on pattern.

Getting a Pattern for Dining Area Cushions:

Boat seats and backs sometimes have angles that need to be identified in order to make cushions that fit. Without a pattern or drawing, You would assume a rectangle.



1. Use the diagram to the right.
2. Measure the length 'a' and record.
3. Measure width 'b' and record.
4. Indicate whether there is an angle by measuring 'c' and then from point 'c' to point 'd'
5. Note any other measurements you think might be helpful in identifying unusual angles, Shapes, etc.
6. Record seat cushion thickness: _____
